

**FORMAL REPORT UNDER SECTION 7 OF THE
NEW ZEALAND BILL OF RIGHTS ACT 1990 IN
RELATION TO THE TRANSPORT SAFETY BILL**

Pursuant to section 7 of the New Zealand Bill of Rights Act 1990, the Attorney-General brings to the attention of the House of Representatives clause 17 of the Transport Safety Bill.

That clause appears, notwithstanding the provisions of section 5 of the New Zealand Bill of Rights Act 1990 (which relates to justified limitations), to be inconsistent with the rights and freedoms contained in sections 21 and 22 of the New Zealand Bill of Rights Act 1991.
